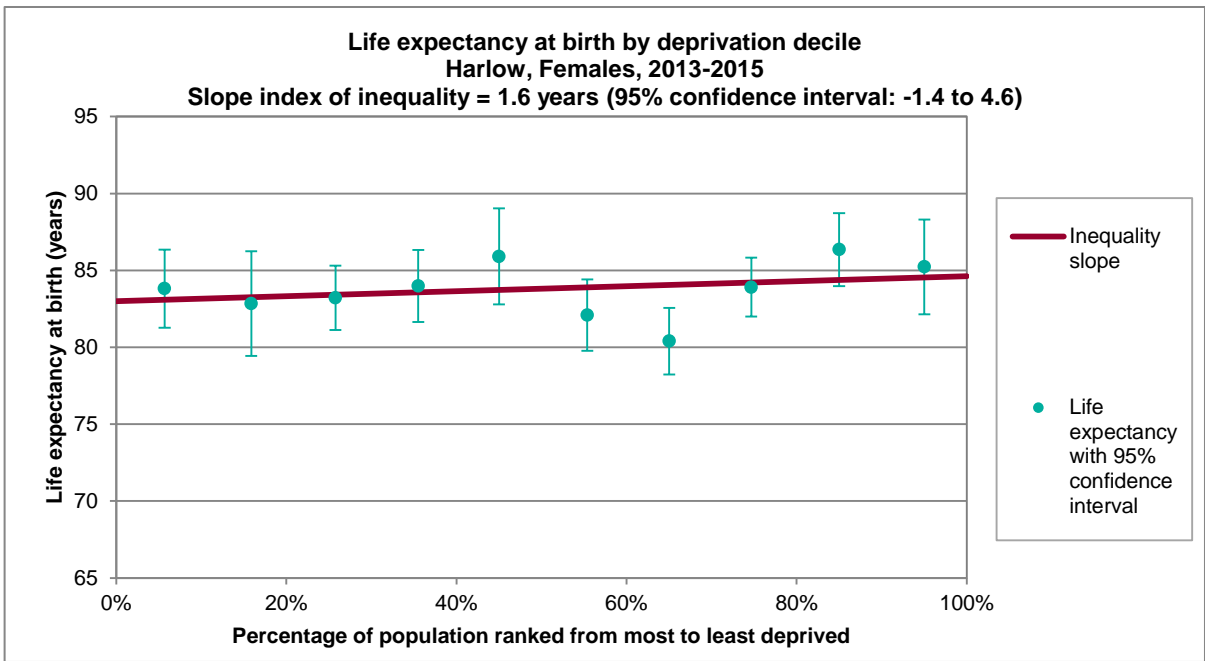


Slope index of inequality in life expectancy at birth within English local authorities, based on local deprivation deciles within each area, 2013-2015

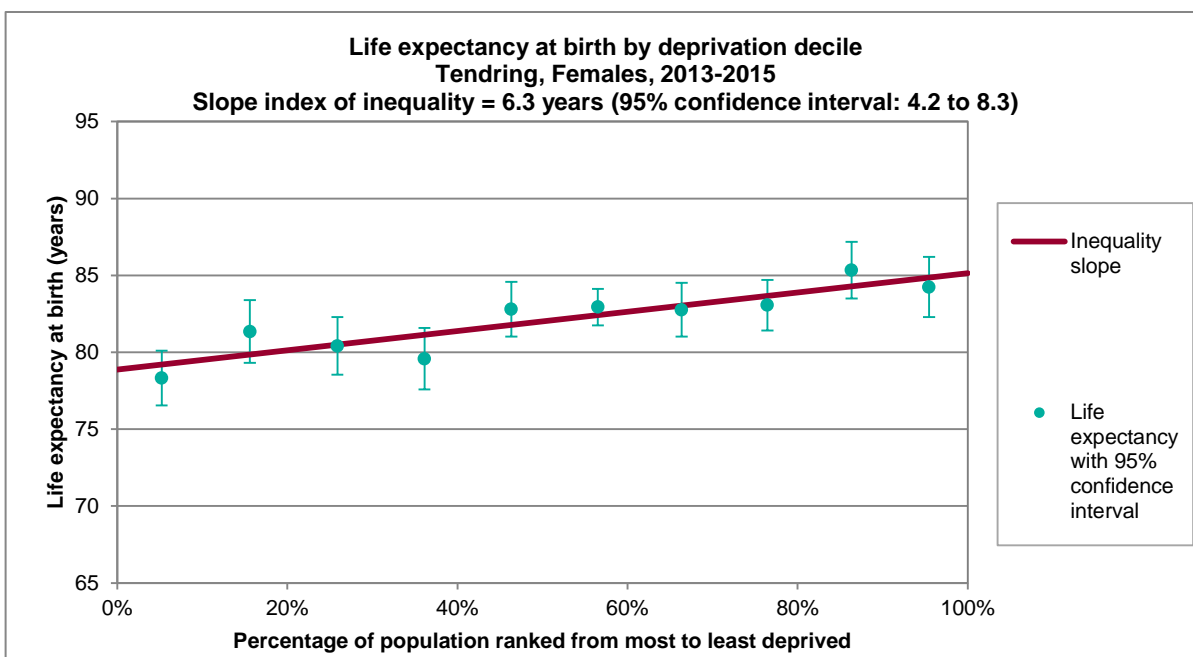

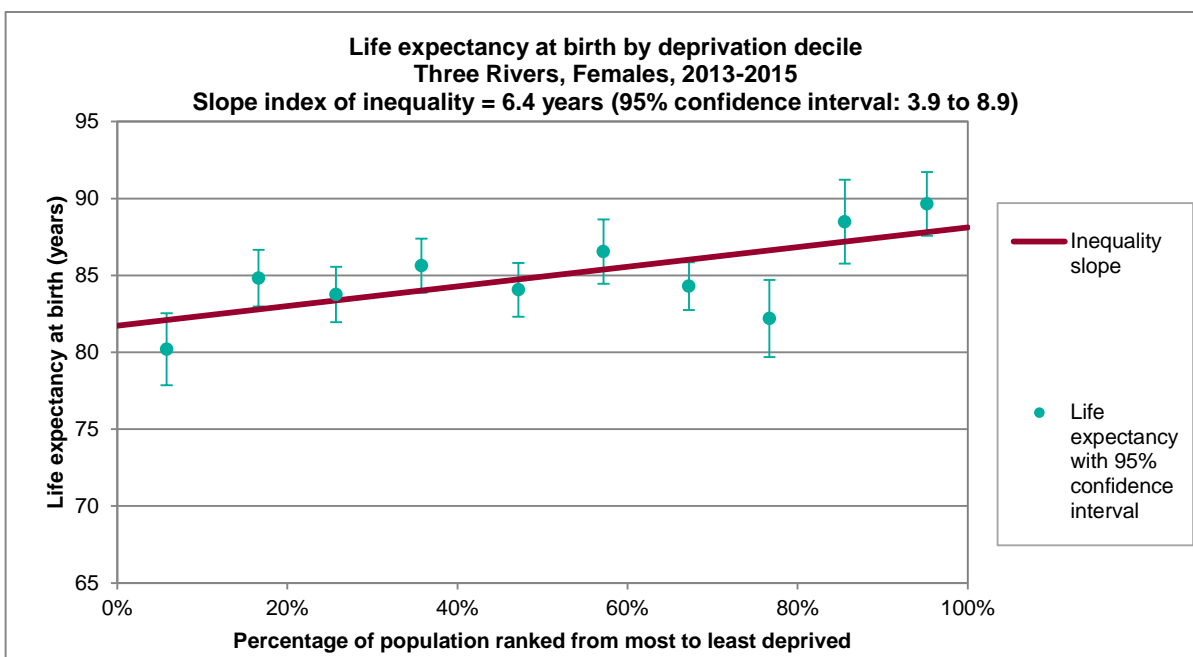

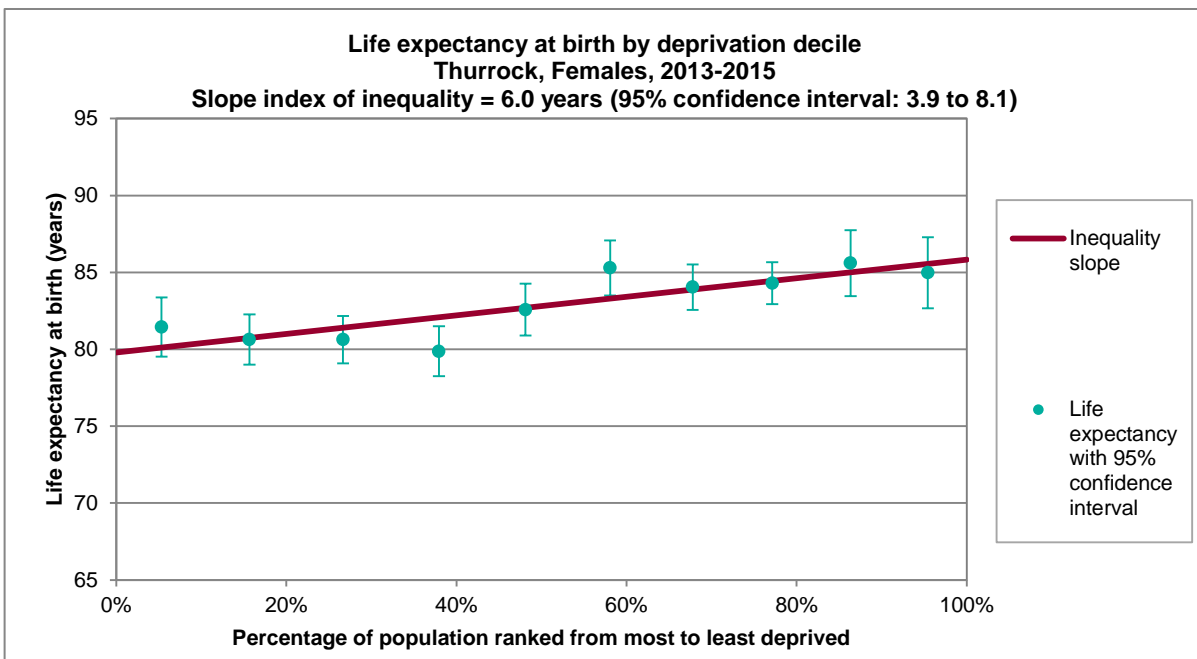


Slope index of inequality in life expectancy at birth within English local authorities, based on local deprivation deciles within each area, 2013-2015

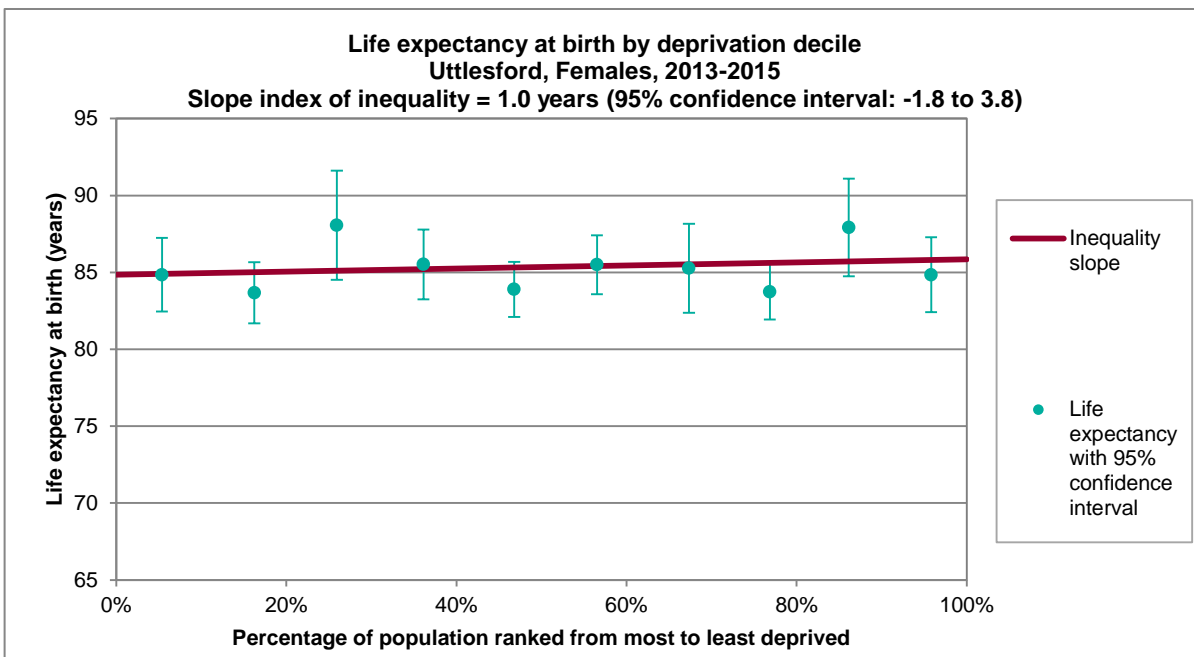

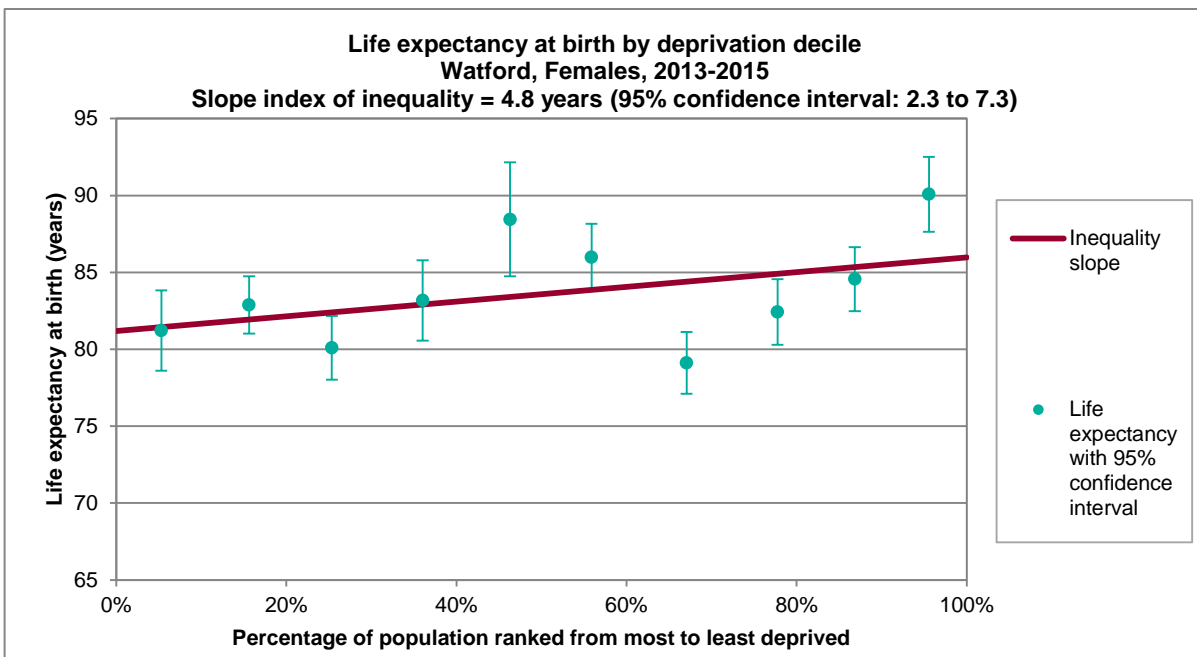

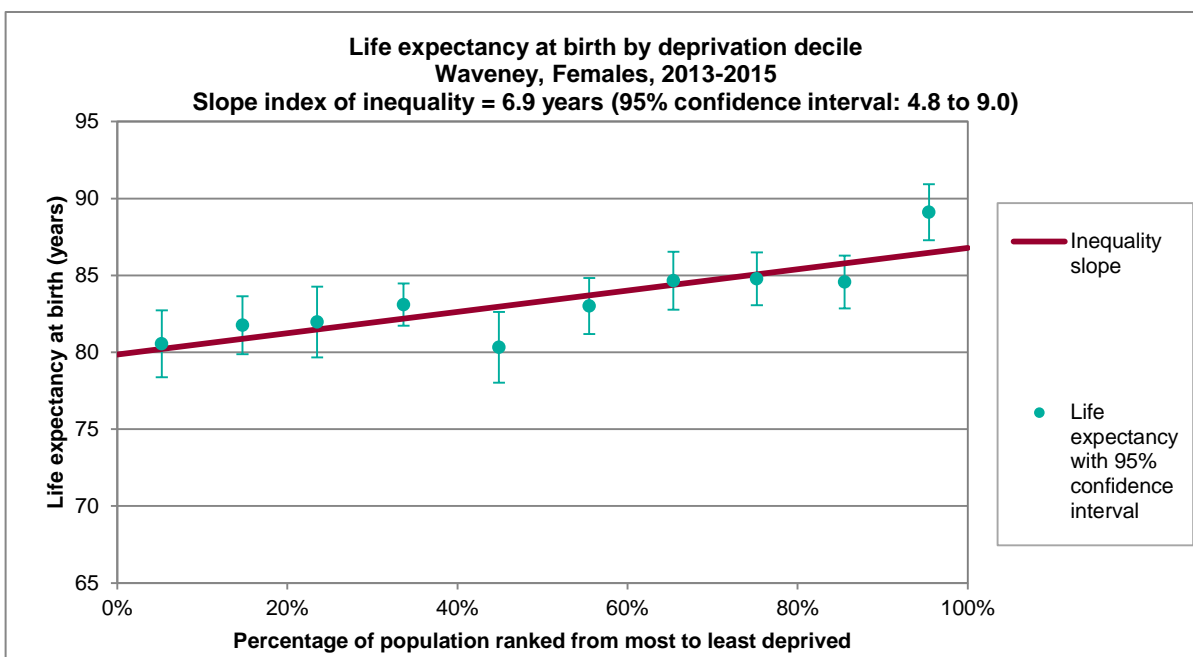

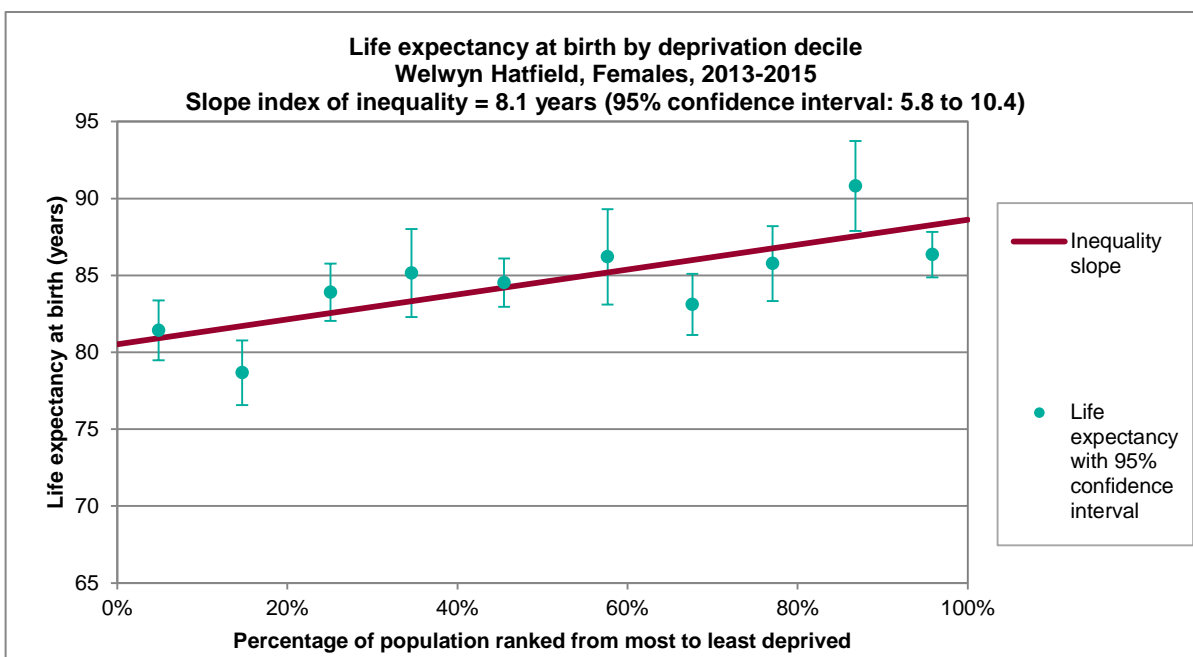
